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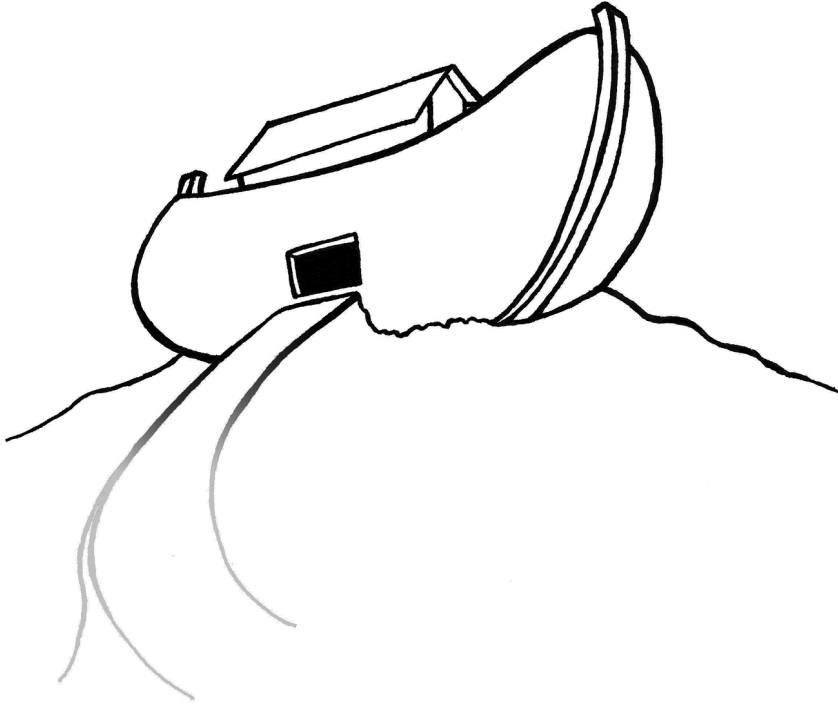
DOODLE TIME:

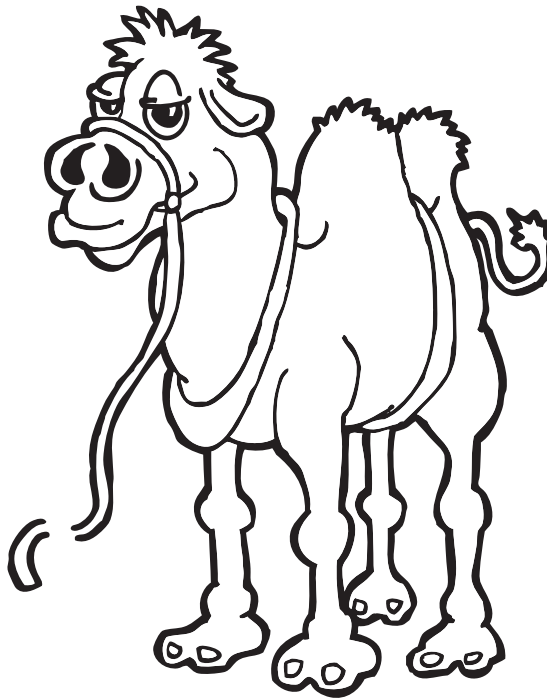
DOODLE TIME:

DOODLE TIME:

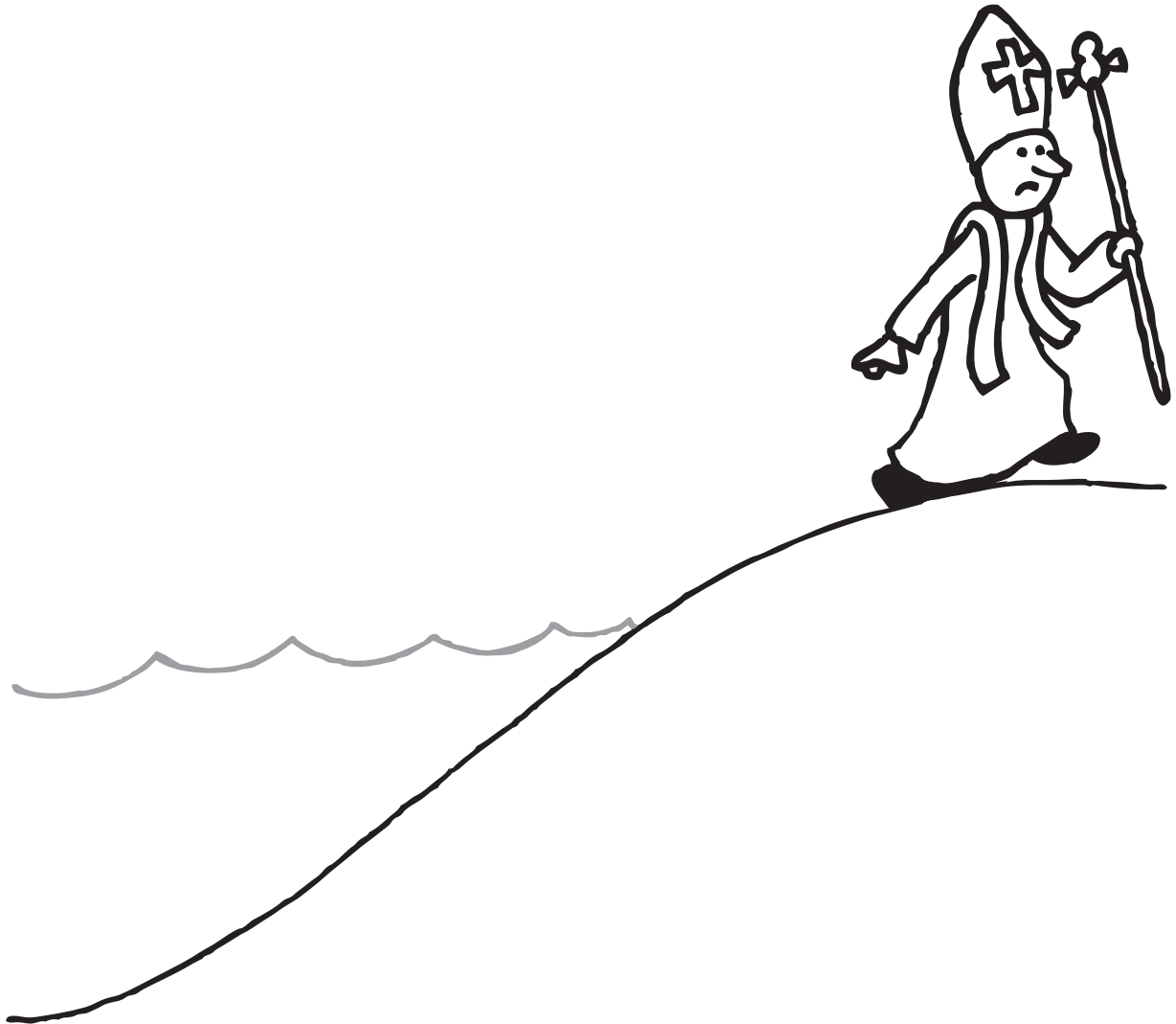
Draw a prophet walking his favorite camel to the watering hole.
